Intimation about the Medical Fit / Unfitness of the Candidates

1. Document verification (DV) for the post of Technician Grade I(Signal) Level-5 under CEN No. 02/2024 was conducted at this RRB on 08.04.2025 with block date on 24.04.2025 respectively. Candidates whose DV was successful were sent for Medical examination at the nominated Railway Hospitals/ Health Units across Southern Railway Jurisdiction.
2. The following candidates who have been found **UNFIT** in the prescribed medical category for the post of Technician Grade I(Signal) have the option to prefer an appeal to the Principal Chief Medical Director (PCMD), Southern Railway, Chennai.

3. Candidate who desires to prefer appeal against the decision of the Railway Medical Authority may submit the same, with relevant documents mentioned below to the Chairman, Railway Recruitment Board, Thiruvananthapuram latest by **18.00** hours of **03.07.2025**. They should submit the appeal by Registered post /Speed Post only. **Belated appeal, if any, will be summarily rejected.**
4. Those candidates who have not attended medical exam / absconded or absented willfully for medical examination before the nominated medical committee for review **are not eligible** to apply for appeal.

Procedure for Appeal

The appeal will be entertained only if: -

1. The candidate produces a certificate in the attached prescribed format (**Proforma A**) from a Government/Private Doctor of the specialty/specialties in which the candidate has been found unfit.
2. Such certificate should contain a note that the doctor/ specialist is fully aware of the physical and visual standards set by the Railways for the particular medical category, and that the doctor/ specialist is aware of the fact that the candidate has already been declared unfit according to these standards during medical examination conducted by an appropriate medical board.
3. The certificate should bear the photograph and mark of identification of the candidates duly attested by such medical certificate issuing authority duly mentioning its MCI/State registration number.
4. Candidate will be required to pay Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) through Demand Draft payable in favour of FA&CAO / Southern Railway, Chennai.

5. Where PCMD is of the opinion that there should be re-examination of the case of appeal, he may nominate a medical board to re-examine the candidate. The decision of PCMD, Southern Railway on the appeal preferred by the candidates will be communicated to them through RRB/Thiruvananthapuram.
6. In case, the decision changes from unfit to fit, the amount of Rs. 1000/- submitted through DD will be refunded to the candidate. In all other cases, the DD amount will be forfeited and the candidates will not have any claim on the same.
7. After this appeal no further chance will be given for medical examination.

Note: Appeal against the medical unfit should be sent by the candidate in his / her own handwriting with signature. The format of specimen appeal is given as Annexure B. The appeal will be entertained with the appeal letter (Annexure B), Medical Certificate (Annexure A) & DD for Rs. 1000/-.
